

Year 4 Topic—The Romans/Newcastle through the ages

Here is a suggestion of some activities linked to what your child has been learning at school. We hope you have fun completing them together.

Read your favourite story to someone in your family. Write a book review and include why it is your favourite book.	Write a story about the Romans.	Design a persuasive poster encouraging people to join the Roman army.
Research Julius Caesar and create a fact file about him.	Use your sketching skills to draw a Roman soldier. Remember to include all of their armour.	Make a model of the Colosseum. Look at pictures and decide which mathematical shapes would work best.
Research Roman inventions then create your own.	Speak to an older relative and find out how Newcastle has changed since they were your age.	Take a walk, can you see anything that was designed by the Romans?
Use Times Tables Rockstars or Maths Frame to practise your times tables.	Design a tourist information leaflet for people who want to visit Newcastle. What do you love about this city?	Choose an activity from the Linking Project sheet in your homework book.
