We will be learning all about animals for this term. We will be identifying, comparing and describing common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, and looking at what they eat. We will also be looking at the human body and our senses.

PE

In PSHE, children will learn about how to promote their own health and wellbeing and how to manage feelings and emotions. We will be learning about the human body.

Children will be able to use past tense vocabulary and begin to identify and sort the main differences between old and new objects. Children will be able to explain how things have changed since they were born. Children can identify and explain why certain objects were different in the past and give plausible explanations for these objects.
