Topic: Elswick through time



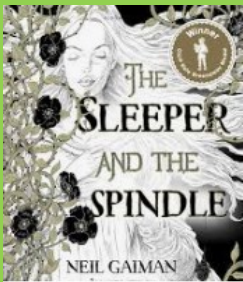
Humanities
