## School messaging and payment system

Schoolgateway



We send information to parents using a **free**, smartphone app called '**School Gateway**' available from your app store.

Please could you download this new app to your phone as it will help us improve communication with parents.

**The set-up process is simple and will take no more than a couple of minutes:**

1. Search for "School Gateway" in the Apple App Store/Google Play **or** on your phone go to [www.schoolgateway.com/apple](http://www.schoolgateway.com/apple) (Apple) or [www.schoolgateway.com/android](http://www.schoolgateway.com/android) (Android)
2. Install the app and if you are asked then say yes to "Allow Push Notifications"
3. When you launch School Gateway for the first time, please select 'New User' and enter the email address and mobile telephone number you have registered with the school.
4. The system will send a PIN code to your phone; please enter this PIN code and the app will be activated for you.

As soon as you've got the system set-up, all of the text messages we send you will appear in the app; you'll receive notifications/alerts as normal.

**If you've recently changed your email address or mobile telephone number, please let us know so we can update our records.**
