### **Science**

# **Properties and Changes of Materials**

Year 5 will become experts on 'Properties and Changes of Materials.' Science lessons will be jam-packed full of practical activities and scientific enquiries to help understand the differences between a variety of materials and how materials can be mixed and dissolved, and reversibly and irreversibly changed.

### **English**

#### World War I
