Here is a suggestion of some activities linked to what your child has been learning at school.

Draw/design an alien , label your alien with things they can do or what they look like	Make a space rocket using recyclable materials	Look for things in your home that are pairs. Same, same! (Pairs of socks, shoes) Write a list of what you found.
Order your toys in size order: • Smallest to largest; • Largest to smallest Write what your biggest and smallest toys are	Make a wanted poster for The Gruffalo.	Go for a walk to the woods and the beach —describe, using your senses. Compare the beach to the woods, what things are similar and what is different? Draw and write about what you think.
Go outside on a mini-beast hunt. Choose a mini-beast to research. What does it look like? What does it eat? Where does it live? Make a poster.	Choose your favourite story book from home, write a book review for it and draw a picture of your favourite page.	Find some different flowers. Use your sketching skills to draw them. Can you show some in black and white and some in colour?
Make a weather report for each day you are at home. Draw the weather and write a sentence to describe it.	Write a list of your favourite colours. Find things around your home or garden that are these colours.	Write a list of things around your home that are: Circle, square, triangle, rectangle, oval.
Make a fruit kebab. Write 4 instructions about how you do it. Why is fruit good for you? What foods are not good for you?	Use the alphabet and find things around your home that begin with that letter.	Can you make a pitta bread pizza with a grown up? Can you write instructions explaining how you made the pizza?
