<p>Find out about Egyptian Gods and Goddesses and then write a fact file about your favourite.</p> 	<p>Draw a map of a pharaoh's tomb. Write a set of instructions on how to safely get through, avoiding any traps! Think about using directional language.</p> 	<p>Write your name and the names of 3 friends or family members in hieroglyphics.</p> 
<p>Write a story set in Ancient Egypt. Think about your choice of sentence openers & co-ordinating conjunctions!</p> 	<p>Make a net for a pyramid.</p> 	<p>Create a painting or drawing of an ancient Egyptian scene using your choice of materials</p>
<p>Design and make a tomb or coffin for an Egyptian mummy.</p> 	<p>Write an acrostic poem using the letters of a key 'topic' word e.g. Egypt, Pharaoh, Tomb.</p>	<p>Write an ancient Egyptian rap or song.</p>
