Pupil Premium

Reporting to parents

Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Allocation for 2015/16 was £174,240

By the end of the year the impact of this spending was as follows.

In **Reception** children in receipt of Pupil Premium did not perform as well as those who are not in receipt of this funding but their progress over the year from a low baseline was good and in Writing was better than children not in receipt of PP funding.

In **Year 2** children in receipt of Pupil Premium are still outperformed by those who do not receive this funding in all areas.

However progress is very good for both groups with Pupil Premium children making greater “More than Expected” progress from reception in Reading & Maths.

By the time the children leave Hawthorn at the end of **Year 6** there is a very positive picture for all pupils with pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium outperforming others in all areas except in the Maths SAT test

The progress that all children made **from Year 2 to Year 6** was Good for those pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium.
