Reading and Writing

- Children could practise writing letters of the alphabet in pre-cursive print (template in reading folders)
- Children should be able to recognise most of the phonics sounds we do in class – they could practise these at home using their daily reading book
- Practise reading these red words (words that cannot be sounded out)

Children should start to segment and spell simple words on their own

Some words to practise: Mum, Dad, cat, dog, fox, clock, web, ten, six, sock, bug.
