Dear Parents / Carers,

New service for children with Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) needs

The number of primary aged school children with SEMH needs is increasing. Hawthorn Primary School is committed to working with Newcastle City Council to ensure there is sufficient specialist support available when required. Together with other schools, we have worked with Newcastle City Council to review the existing SEMH provision, and identify what support is required going forward.

The LA has agreed to significantly invest in a central provision, which will be accessible to all schools across Newcastle. A new service will provide a swift response to requests for help. Support will be available via out-reach and in-reach delivered by specialist teachers and support assistants. The outreach service will support all schools, and the LA aim to have it in place for September 2023. The in-reach service will be available from September 2024 and will be a single hub of 24 places.

To support this development, the LA is proposing to close the SEMH Additional Resourced Provisions (ARPs) across the city. These ARPs are currently based in 3 Primary Schools, one of which is Hawthorn Primary School. In accordance with the DFE's Guidance on making significant changes, the Board of Governors of Hawthorn Primary School is consulting on the proposal to close the ARP for primary aged pupils, who have an SEMH additional need.

You are invited to respond to the consultation via the form at the end of this letter. All responses must be received by Friday 16th June 2023.
