<p>Collect as many different types of materials that you can find in your house. Remember, materials include plastic, glass as well as fabric</p>	<p>Using the materials you have found, write a list of their uses.</p>	<p>Create a healthy meal for Rapunzel. Draw a picture and label the different food groups.</p>
