Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Allocation for 2016/17 was £175,760

By the end of the year the impact of this spending was as follows.

In Reception children in receipt of Pupil Premium did not perform quite as well as those who are not in receipt of this funding but at a higher level than previous years. Their progress over the year from a low baseline was good and in all subjects was better than children not in receipt of PP funding. (No national figures yet – Oct 17)

In **Year 2** children in receipt of Pupil Premium are still outperformed by those who do not receive this funding in all areas.

By the time the children leave Hawthorn at the end of **Year 6** there is a positive picture for all pupils with pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium especially in Maths. Average standard scores are higher for pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium. More Pupil Premium children achieved Greater Depth than last years cohort.
