On **Monday 13th July**, we would like to invite you in to school to receive your child's end of year report for the current academic year 2019-2020. We will only be reporting on a period of time prior to the pandemic COVID-19 (Autumn term until school closed to most pupils on the 20th March 2020.)

The table below shows the time that each year group can collect their end of year reports. Only one Parent/Carer should come to school to pick-up the report. If you have more than one child, all of your children's reports will be available when you collect your youngest child's report. For example, if you have children in Year 1, Year 3 and Year 5, you should come at the Year 1 time slot when you will be able to collect all three reports.

The report must be handed to a Parent/Carer and cannot be taken home by a child. With your child's report, you will also receive information about plans for school in September including who their new class teacher will be. If you would like to discuss anything in your child's report, please phone school and we will arrange for your child's class teacher to contact you by phone, at a convenient time.

Many of the children have been working hard on the home-learning activities and we would like to thank Parents/Carers for supporting them and school during this time. Home-learning activities will finish at the end of term on the 17th July.
