#### School Gateway



We are moving away from using School Ping and will be now using **School Gateway** for both messages and payments.

You can now make payments online to the school for things like dinner money and school trips.

You will have received an email, during the summer holidays, with instructions on how to access this system.

If you've recently changed your email address or mobile telephone number, please let us know so we can update our records.

If you are having trouble accessing the system, please speak to a member of staff at the office and we will try and help.

#### Attendance

It is important your child attends school every day.



Please phone the school office **before <u>08:40am</u>** to let school know if they are going to be absent.

Please make any appointments out of school hours; if this is not possible we will require a copy of the appointment before we can authorise the absence.

#### <u>Uniform</u>
