Literacy: Reading and Writing

We will ...

Share lots of different stories and look at different countries, habitats and animals - 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar,' 'Rumble in the Jungle,' Welcome' and 'Immi.' We will also look at a range of non-fiction books. We will write about what we find when we are exploring, write simple stories and make factual leaflets.

Can segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together.

Uses some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning, representing some sounds correctly and in sequence.

Write a simple sentence without overt adult support.

Mathematics

We will ...

Create butterfly symmetry, caterpillar patterns, doubling and halving, addition and subtraction. Some of us will be solving problems in two's, fives, and tens. We will explore shape, time and money.

Begin using the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting. Records, using marks that they can interpret and explain. Begins to identify own mathematical problems based on own interests and fascinations.

Uses everyday language related to time.

Beginning to use everyday language related to money.
