Literacy: Create a Fact File on a number of your favourite Greek Gods that live upon mount Olympus. You could even make a series of posters of your favourite different Greek Gods.	Literacy: Turn a myth into a comic strip, for example, Theseus and the Minotaur. Use lots of speech bubbles. Then bring it in to share with your friends!	Art: Create a picture of your very own imaginary Greek God or Mythical creature. Make sure your poster is eye-catching and full of facts and information. You can draw your picture or use ICT.
