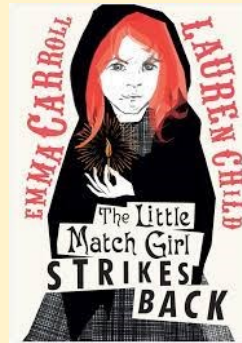


Science
